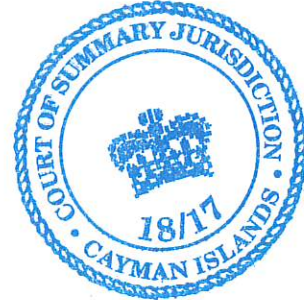

THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this **Plaint** on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out full particulars of your defence in the space provided in the Acknowledgment of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a default judgment without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times a company organised and carrying on business pursuant to the laws of the Cayman Islands. The Plaintiff's address for service is HSM Chambers, 68 Fort Street, George Town, P.O. Box 31726, Grand Cayman, KY1-1207, Cayman Islands.
2. The Defendant is an individual who resides in the Cayman Islands with an address of 942 South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. On or around 29 August 2019, the Defendant attended our offices in relation to Immigration advice. During this meeting, The Defendant was informed of the consultation fee of US\$600.00 in relation to the Immigration advice.
4. On or around 31 August 2018, an email was sent to the Defendant attaching Invoice #4260066 for his attention and payment for the services rendered.
5. The following invoice was sent to the Defendant in relation to services rendered:

4260066	US\$600.00	31 August 2018

Despite several requests for payment sent by email to the Defendant on 2 October 2018 and 30 January 2019. To date, the Defendant has not paid the outstanding sum of US\$600.00 towards the outstanding invoice.

6. The Defendant has defaulted on the terms of the Invoice and as of the date of the commencement of these proceedings, the Defendant owes to the Plaintiff the principal sum of US\$600.00 with interest of US\$27.29 from 14 September 2018 to 27 February 2019 and continuing to accrue at the rate of 10% per annum, being US\$0.16 per day.
7. As a result of the above, the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief claimed in this proceeding.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- a) US\$600.00 being the principal sum due as at 27 February 2019.

- b) Pre and post judgment interest from calculated from 14 September 2018 to 27 February 2019 in the sum of US\$27.29 and continuing at the rate of US\$0.16 per day in accordance with the terms of the Invoice;
- c) Costs in accordance with the summary Court Rules 2004;
- d) Such further and other relief as this Court may deem just.

INDORSEMENT

2. The prescribed rate of interest is 10% per annum.
3. The date from which interest is payable is from 14 September 2018.
4. The amount of interest accruing due each day is US\$0.16 per day.
