**CONSENT ORDER**

**UPON THIS MATTER** coming on for hearing this 14<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18th days of November, 1997 **AND UPON** hearing Counsel for the Petitioner, and Counsel for the Respondent **AND UPON** reading the affidavits filed herein on behalf of each of the parties **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY CONSENT**

1 That the Petitioner have sole custody, care and control of the relevant children of the marriage with reasonable access being granted to the Respondent.

2 That the Respondent do pay maintenance of CI\$250.00 per month for each of the three children of the marriage namely **RICHARD HUGH BARTON** who was born on 9<sup>th</sup> December, 1979, which maintenance shall be payable until he completes his formal education at the Community College, and for **CRAIG MARIO BARTON** who was born on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 1981 and **TASHA MARIE BARTON** who was born on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 1984 which payments shall continue until each of the said children shall attain the age of 17 years or complete their formal education, whichever is later, all of which payments shall be made through the Courts Funds Office.

2 That the Respondent do make a lump sum payment to the Petitioner in the form of 2/3rds of the arrears outstanding on the former matrimonial home which arrears currently stand at CI\$16,296.00.


3 Upon the payment of the said 2/3rds of the arrears, the Respondent's interest in the former matrimonial home is to be transferred to the Petitioner, absolutely and the Petitioner shall then take over all payments in relation to the mortgage on the home and shall thereafter indemnify the Respondent for any and all claims, if any, made against the said property provided that the basis for such claims arose after the date of the said transfer of the property to the Petitioner, absolutely..

4 The Respondent and the Petitioner shall share equally in the reasonably and properly incurred educational, medical, optical and dental expenses relating to the relevant children of the marriage until they attain the age of 17 years or complete their education, whichever is later.

5 That there is liberty for each of the parties to apply as to the working of this Order.
