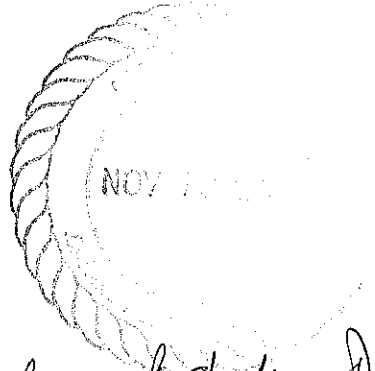

1. **THAT** the time for the service of this Originating Summons be abridged.
2. **THAT** this Honourable Court do give such directions as it may deem fit and proper as to whether, and if so, subject to what conditions, the Applicants may be permitted to disclose to the Plaintiff and permit the Plaintiff to take copies of:
 - (a) all correspondence passing between the Applicants and/or each of them and the First and/or Second Defendants;
 - (b) all statements, advice notes, paid cheques, debit and credit vouchers, transfers, applications, orders, instructions, internal memoranda and other documents, relating to any account at Lines Overseas Management (Cayman) Limited and/or Lines Overseas Management Limited in the names of the First and/or Second Defendants whether individually or jointly with other parties or in

relation to any account with Lines Overseas Management (Cayman) Limited and/or Lines Overseas Management Limited in relation to which either the First or Second Defendants are or were signatories.

3. **THAT** this Honourable Court do give such further or other directions as it may deem fit.
