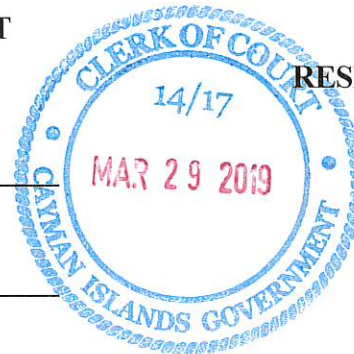

PETITION

The Petition of Trudy-Ann Scott shows:

1. That on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 2013 in Freeport, Grand Bahamas, Bahamas, the Petitioner was lawfully married to the Respondent. At the time of their marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows:
  - a. the Petitioner was a single person, and
  - b. the Respondent was a widower.
2. Following the celebration of the said marriage the parties cohabited in the Cayman Islands.
3. That the Court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason that the Petitioner has been ordinarily resident and domiciled in the Cayman Islands for a period in excess of two years prior to the presentation of this Petition.
4. That there have been no previous proceedings brought by the parties hereto in any Court with respect to the said marriage and there is no impediment to the Honourable Court granting a decree of dissolution of marriage.

5. That the parties have been separated since 12 March 2016 and the Respondent consents to the parties dissolving their marriage.
6. That there is one child of the marriage, namely:
  - a. Gabrielle Danah Scott (D.O.B. 20<sup>th</sup> May 2015) (hereinafter “the child”).
7. The Petitioner and Respondent have resolved all issues related to the child.
8. The Petitioner and Respondent have reached an agreement on the division of their assets and debts.
9. The Petitioner and Respondent have resolved all issues related to maintenance.

**THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:**

- A. That the said marriage be dissolved.
- B. That the parties’ ancillary matters be settled on the terms already agreed between the parties.
- C. That there be no order as to Costs.



4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open Court unless an acknowledgment of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
