

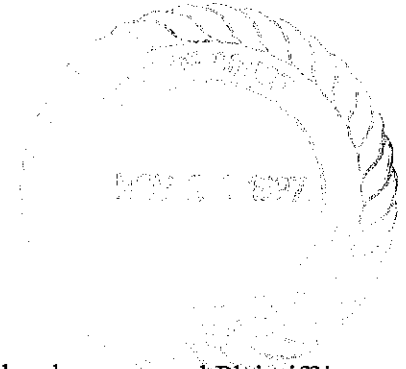

Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court).



2. The sum of CI\$275.00 being the cost of medical attention and damage to the Plaintiff's motorcar.
3. An injunction restraining the Defendant by herself, her servants, agents or otherwise howsoever from assaulting, molesting or otherwise interfering with the Plaintiff.
4. The Plaintiff claims interests pursuant to the Judicature Law.
5. The Plaintiff claims costs.
6. That the Plaintiff be given such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court deems appropriate.
