PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

The Humble Petition for Dissolution of Marriage of **HANK ALLEN BODDEN Snr.** whose address is # 25 Autumn Lane, George Town, Grand Cayman shows: -

1. That on the 28th day of October, 1995 the Petitioner was lawfully married to the Respondent. At the time of the said marriage, the Petitioner was single, and the Respondent was single.
2. That following the celebration of the marriage, the parties lived and cohabited in a house on family land at # 25 Autumn Lane, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. That this Honorable Court has jurisdiction in this matter, by reason of the fact that the Petitioner was born in the Cayman Islands and has been domiciled here all of his life, up to and including one year before the presentation of this Petition.
4. That there are no relevant children of the marriage.
5. That there have been no previous proceedings brought by this Petitioner or Respondent in this or any other court in respect of the said marriage.
6. That there is no impediment to this Honourable Court granting a Decree of Dissolution of Marriage known to the Petitioner, and there is no prospect whatsoever, of a reconciliation between the parties.

7. That there are no arrangements made between the parties for the consideration of this Honourable Court.
8. That the marriage has broken down irretrievably.
9. That since the celebration of the marriage, the parties have lived separate and apart for more than ten years.

PARTICULARS

- (a) That the parties last lived together as man and wife in or about 2009.
- (b) That the marriage broke down in 2009, and the Petitioner moved out of the home and the parties have not resumed co-habitation since that time. They have lived lives separate and apart since that time.
10. That the Petitioner is in no doubt whatsoever that the marriage has broken down irretrievably.

AND THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS: -

- (a) That the said marriage be dissolved
- (b) That this Honourable Court do make any other order that it may deem just.



**IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE
HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY**

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgement of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgement of Service must be filed at Court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of Divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an Acknowledgement of Service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court Office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands, the period within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgement of Service and any Answer are extended by Fourteen days.

Attorney: Where the Respondent is represented by an Attorney, state the Attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Respondent may not act by a foreign Attorney.

Respondent in person: Where the Respondent is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence, or if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent.
