
APPLICATION TO RESEAL FOREIGN GRANT OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY

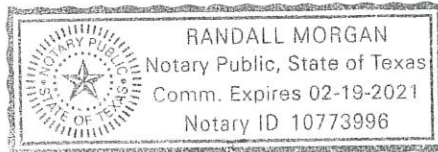
We are over the age of eighteen years and have not renounced probate.


We apply for the resealing of the Foreign Grant. We enclose our affidavits in that behalf and we undertake that in the event of a resealed grant being made to us, we will:
