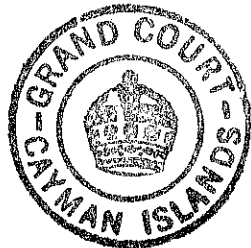

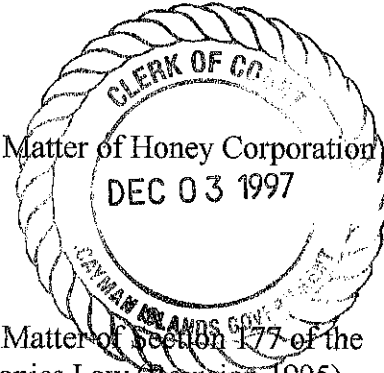




ORIGINATING SUMMONS
