### STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times the spouse of the Defendant and she resides at 2215 Shamrock Road, Grand Cayman;
2. The Defendant is employed as a mason with the Construction firm of Arch & Godfrey at George Town, Grand Cayman. The Plaintiff is employed as a Caregiver to two elderly persons in Lower Valley, Grand Cayman;
3. On or about the 2 July 2016 the Plaintiff and the Defendant had a domestic argument. The defendant without provocation viciously attacked the Plaintiff with a Machete chopping her on her Wrist and forearm causing a serious Ms-3Cm laceration;
4. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Plaintiff sustained severe personal injuries and has suffered pain loss and damage.

#### Particulars of Injuries

- a) The Plaintiff received severe Laceration to her left wrist and forearm with the machete causing severe bleeding and pain;
- b) The Plaintiff was admitted to the George Town Hospital where she received stitches to close the wound and lidocaine infiltration treatment and treatment for pain;
- c) The injuries to the Plaintiff's hand almost caused the loss of the hand; the Plaintiff's doctor stated that if the machete was Sharper, it would have severed the hand;
- d) The Plaintiff's injured hand remained swollen for 6 months and still remains numb and without pressure.

#### Particulars of Special Damage

- a) Loss of earnings for 3 weeks CI\$ 275:00 per week;
  - b) Medical treatment, prescription bills approximately, CI\$ 480:00.
5. Further, in acting aforesaid the defendant was actuated by malevolence or spite towards the Plaintiff and he thereby intended to and did humiliate the Plaintiff in the presence of friends and family and subjected her to ridicule and contempt in public by reason whereof the injury to the Plaintiff has been greatly aggravated.
6. On or about the second week in July 2016 the Defendant was arrested by the Royal Cayman Island Police Service (RCIPS) where he was formally charged for assault Actual Bodily Harm. The matter

proceeded to the Summary Court where the Honourable Court dealt with the matter in the form of an Order for counseling and probation.

7. On or about 6 February 2018, the Defendant became abusive to the Plaintiff again, causing fear and apprehension in the Plaintiff that she would be attacked again. The RCIPS was called on this occasion and they requested that the Defendant leave the home that he and the Plaintiff occupied.

And the Plaintiff Claims

1. Special damages: CI \$1,305.00;
2. Damages on the footing of aggravated damages;
3. Interest thereon at such rate and for such period as this Honourable Court shall think fit;
4. Costs;
5. Such or further relief as this Honourable Court shall think fit.
