

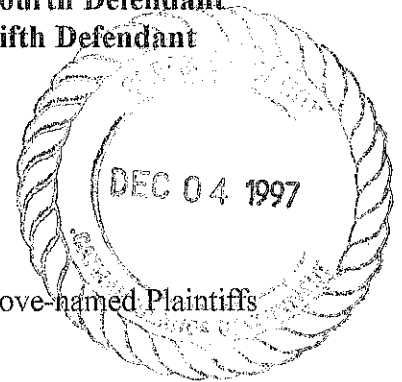
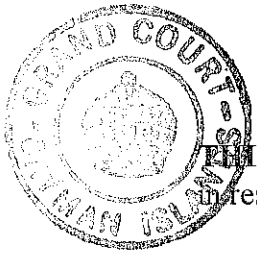

WRIT OF SUMMONS



**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of a claim set out the next page.

**Within** fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.


## INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiffs, Wilbur Dacosta, Araunah Powery, Robert Ebanks, and Audrey Thompson-Ebanks are Registered under the Registered Land Law of the Cayman Islands, Law 21 of 1971 as the Registered Proprietors of land described therein as Block 5B Parcel 139. They hold the said land in Trust for the benefit and for and on behalf of the Church of God (Full Gospel Hall) and bring this action for and on behalf of the said Church of God (Full Gospel Hall) for:-

1. An Injunction to restrain the defendants whether by themselves or their agents or servants or otherwise howsoever from doing the following acts or any of them that is to say:-
  - a. Trespassing on land owned by the plaintiffs by preventing the second named plaintiff from performing his functions and/or duties of Acting Pastor of the Church of God (Full Gospel Hall) at West Bay located on the land hereinbefore mentioned.
  - b. Trespassing on the said land and preventing the second named plaintiff from entering the Pulpit and preaching therefrom.
  - c. Trespassing on the said land and preventing the second named plaintiff from discharging his function and/or duties as Acting Pastor from presiding over services
  - d. Trespassing on the said land owned by the plaintiffs and asserting that the first named defendant was the Pastor
  - e. The first named defendant from performing acts such as preaching from the Pulpit of the said church without being authorised so to do by the Acting Pastor, the second named plaintiff.
  - f. The first named defendant from entering on the said land and authorising persons to paint the church building without the authority and/or approval of the Acting Pastor, the second named plaintiff.
  - g. Breaking the locks put on to the church doors by the plaintiffs and entering in the said church and conducting services therein without the authority and/or approval of the second named plaintiff, the Acting Pastor.
  - h. Changing the locks put on the doors of the said church by the plaintiffs and putting on different locks in order to and thereby prevent the second named plaintiff from entering and performing his functions and/or duties of Acting Pastor.

- i. Entereing on the land and asserting to members of the congregation of the said church that the second named plaintiff was no longer going to be allowed to have any service and that the first named defendant had taken over.
- j. Entering on the said land and asserting that the second named defendant was the Assistant Pastor.
- k. Dislocating the Pulpit and the benches in the church to prevent the second named plaintiff, the Acting Pastor from conducting service.
- l The said defendants from destroying the fence put up by the plaintiffs
- m. The said defendants from erecting a fence around the plaintiff's land referred to supra.
2. Damages.
3. Costs.
