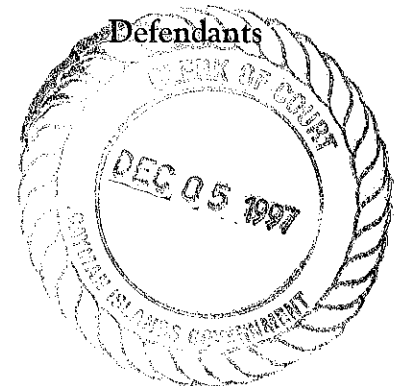
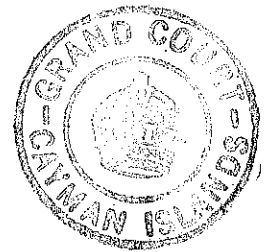

LET the Defendants within 14 days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the above-named Plaintiffs, SIMON CHARLES EDGAR GENTILLI of Huttons Farm, Hambledon, near Henley-on-Thames, Oxfordshire RG9 6NE, England, RICHARD EDGAR BETHEL SOLOMONS of Fell Edge Farm, Straight Lane, Addingham Moorside aforesaid and DIANA JEAN HUNTINGFORD of Hemingstone Hall, Ipswich, Suffolk IP6 9RE, England who (subject to the exercise of certain discretionary powers by the Trustee) are entitled to the entire capital and income of the fund subject to the trusts of the said Settlement, the Plaintiffs seek the following relief, that is to say:

1. that an arrangement varying the trusts of the Settlement dated 14 January 1959 and made between the late Gilbert Harold Samuel Edgar ("the Settlor") and Bahamas International Trust Company Limited as Trustee ("the Settlement") as set forth in a draft exhibited to an affidavit sworn on 7 November 1997 and to be filed in these proceedings by the Plaintiff SIMON CHARLES EDGAR GENTILLI may be approved by the Court on behalf of the infant Defendants and on behalf of all persons unborn unknown or unascertained who are or may hereafter become beneficially interested under the trusts of the Settlement with such variations as may be requested by the Plaintiffs and so approved;
2. that the Fourth Defendant may be appointed to represent all the minor great-grandchildren of the Settlor;
3. that it may be declared that on the true construction of the said Settlement and in the events which have happened no child of the daughter of the Settlor Gillian Ruth Evaline Sinclair-Hogg (formerly Solomons) who may be born hereafter is a person who may become beneficially interested under the trusts of the Settlement or alternatively that there is no possibility of such a child being born;
4. that the costs of these proceedings may be provided for in the manner following, that is to say, that there be no order in respect of the costs of the Plaintiffs, that the Defendant ROYAL BANK OF CANADA TRUST COMPANY (CAYMAN) LIMITED be authorised to raise retain and pay its costs and expenses of and incidental to the negotiation and preparation of the said arrangement and these proceedings (whether incurred before or after the issue of the Originating Summons) on the indemnity basis or in such other manner as the Court may direct and that the Plaintiffs do pay the costs and expenses of and incidental to the negotiation and preparation of the said arrangement and these proceedings (whether incurred before or after the issue of the Originating

Summons) of the other Defendants on the indemnity basis of in such other manner as the Court may direct; and

5. that such further or other relief may be granted as this Honourable Court may think fit.

This Application is made under Sections 60 and 68 of the Trusts Law (1996 Revision)

If any Defendant does not acknowledge service, such Judgement may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

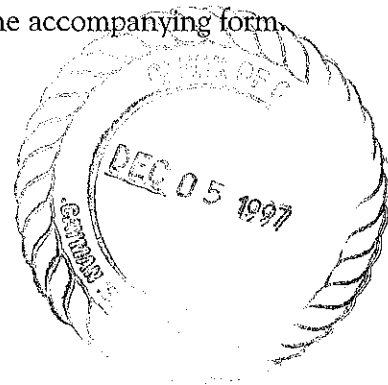
