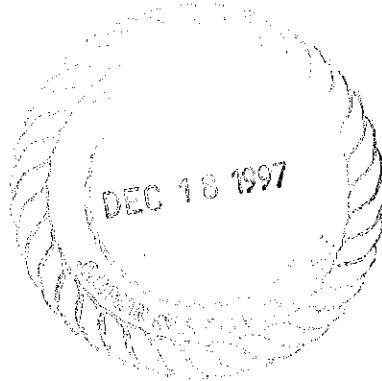

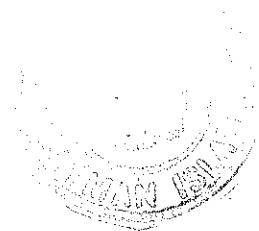
APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION
