ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT, of 5 Corella Road, Newlands, Grand Cayman, attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2019, at o'clock in the noon on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following the following Orders:

1. That the Registrar of Lands be directed to remove the name of the Defendant as a joint proprietor of the West Bay South Block 5B Parcel 180 on the basis that the Registration was obtained by duress.
2. That the Defendant be restrained whether by himself, his agents and/or servants from assaulting, molesting, annoying, threatening or in any other way interfering with the Plaintiff as she goes about her lawful business.
3. That the Defendant be prohibited from preventing the children and grandchildren of the Plaintiff from visiting or staying with her at her residence at 5 Corella Drive, Bodden Town, Grand Cayman.
4. That the Defendant be restrained whether by himself, his agents and/or servants from assaulting, molesting, annoying, threatening or in any other way interfering with the said children and grandchildren of the Plaintiff on such occasions as they or any of them visits or stays with the Plaintiff at her residence at 5 Corella Drive, Bodden Town, Grand Cayman.
5. That a Penal Notice be issued against the Defendant in respect of any breaches of paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 hereof.
6. That the Defendant's name on the Plaintiff's Life Insurance Policies at the BritCay Insurance Company Limited be removed.
7. That there be such further Order as the Court deems appropriate in the circumstances.

8. That the Defendant do bear the costs of these proceedings.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on her counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
