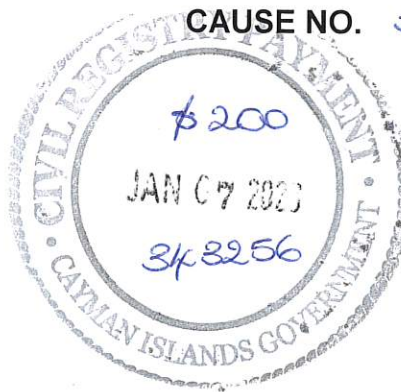

The grounds of this application and upon which said reliefs are sought are:

1. **THAT** the decision of the Immigration Appeals Tribunal dated 26 November 2019 and conveyed to the Appellant and Application on 23 September 2016 was unreasonable.
