2. That the costs of this application be costs in the winding up of Genoa Corporation (In Voluntary Liquidation).

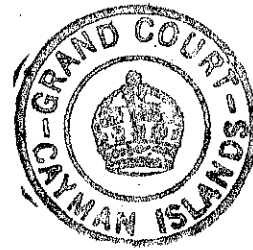
