
PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him).

- (1) The Plaintiff on September 14, 2018 consulted the Defendant and engaged her services to file for her divorce by way of consent. The Defendant outlined that her fee is \$5,000.00 CI. The Plaintiff made payments to the defendant in the amount of \$4,485.00 CI.
- (2) The Defendant on December 3, 2018 notified the Plaintiff that the Judge has approve her Consent Order and he is requesting a meeting with all parties involved before he grants the divorce and she is requesting an additional \$2,500.00 CI to attend the meeting.
- (3) The Plaintiff told the Defendant that she was unable to pay this additional \$2,500.00 CI but was advised by her that whenever she is paid this cash she will proceed with the case.
- (4) The Plaintiff on March 15, 2019 attended the Courts Office and made enquiries on her case. Feeling unsatisfied with the proceedings she acquired the relevant documents to act on her own and was able to obtain her Consent Ancillary Order and Decree of Dissolution of Marriage granted without having to attend any meeting with the Judge.
- (5) The Defendant is demanding that she be paid the remainder of her fee of \$515.00 CI. The Plaintiff however, is requesting that the Defendant refund the \$4,485.00 CI and return all documents as she did not receive the services she paid for but was only being misled.
