
## PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Defendant is indebted to the Plaintiff in the sum of CI\$1,694.76 being the balance of unpaid installments under a written Settlement Agreement (“the Agreement”) executed by the parties on 16<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
2. The Plaintiff made one payment of CI\$332.00 towards the Agreement total of CI\$2,026.76 on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
3. The Plaintiff has written to the Defendant on several occasions to demand payment of the outstanding balance, but at the time of preparing this Plaint, the Defendant has in breach of the Agreement failed to pay.
4. The Defendant is and remains indebted to the Plaintiff in the amount of CI\$1,694.76..
5. The Plaintiff is entitled to and claims interest pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the prescribed rate of 2% per annum on CI\$2,026.76 from the date of the breach, 10<sup>th</sup> September 2017, to the date of this Plaint, as well as the per diem rate until the monies owed have been paid.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

The total sum of CI\$ 1,921.81 being:

- (a) the principal sum of CI\$1,694.76 plus;
- (b) interest in the sum of CI\$ 22.05; calculated at the prescribed rate of 2.375% from 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019 to the date of this Plaint [200 days at the daily rate of CI\$0.11 = CI\$22.05] and continuing at CI\$0.11 per day until judgment or earlier payment; plus
- (c) Fixed costs of CI\$150 + the issue fee of CI\$25.00 + bailiff's fee for service CI\$ 30.00 = CI\$ 205.00
