
**GROUND ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT**

**The grounds of this application and upon which said reliefs are sought are:**

1. **THAT** the decision of the Immigration Appeals Tribunal dated 23 December 2019 and conveyed to the Appellant and Application on 30 January 2018 was unreasonable.
2. **THAT** the Immigration Appeals Tribunal failed to adequately consider the Appellant's points of his work experience and education.
3. **THAT** the Immigration Appeals Tribunal failed to adequately consider the Appellant's Community Involvement.
4. **THAT** the Immigration Appeals Tribunal conducted itself in a discriminatory manner when it failed to adequately consider or at all, the desirability of granting permanent residence to the Appellant, on the basis that he is a Jamaican and the Tribunal's decision to award "0" points under the heading Demographic and Cultural Diversity, to the Appellant, is unreasonable, on the ground that the Appellant would contribute to the "balance in the social and economic life of the country", with the Appellant having demonstrated that he is a productive, law abiding individual.

**The Applicant prays for an oral hearing of this application for leave to apply for Judicial Review.**
