PETITION FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE



THE PETITION OF ANNIE RAMOS for dissolution of marriage shows that:

1. That on the 5th July 2008, the Petitioner ANNIE RAMOS was lawfully married to the Respondent ANDRES RAMOS RODRIGUEZ at West Bay Beach, West Bay Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands. At the time of the said marriage, the marital status of the parties was as follows:

ANNIE RAMOS - Spinster
ANDRES RAMOS RODRIGUEZ - Bachelor
2. The parties have since the celebration of the marriage lived and cohabited as husband and wife at 20 Brookstone Close, Newlands Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. This Honourable court has jurisdiction in this matter by reason that the Petitioner is Caymanian and she is resident and domiciled in the Cayman Islands for several years.
4. There have been no previous proceedings brought by the Petitioner or Respondent in this jurisdiction or otherwise.

5. There is no impediment to this Honourable Court granting a decree of dissolution of the marriage known to the Petitioner and there is no prospect whatsoever of reconciliation between the parties.
6. The marriage has irretrievably broken down and the Petitioner relies on the unreasonable behaviour on the part of the Respondent as set out below:

PARTICULARS OF UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOUR

- (a) The Petitioner and the Respondent are not happy in marriage. The relationship between the parties has deteriorated.
 - (b) The Respondent is abusive to the Petitioner.
 - (c) There is no affection in the marriage and communication is at a minimum.
 - (d) The parties have little in common apart from their two children of the marriage.
 - (e) The Petitioner has moved out of the family home which she owns along with the children to keep the peace and for the children's welfare.
 - (f) The marriage has no future and the Petitioner has decided that a divorce is the best way to secure a peaceful future for all parties concerned and especially the children.
7. The Petitioner has no longer any trust in maintaining the marriage and she is of the firm belief that the marriage has irretrievably broken down by reasons of the facts and circumstances set out.
 8. There are two children of the marriage, Gaven Ramos date of birth 2nd October 2009 and Mathias Ramos date of birth 8th November 2012.

9. There are ancillary issues to be resolved in Chambers.

AND THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:

(a) That the marriage be dissolved;

(b) Any such further Order has the court deems appropriate and just.

3. The Acknowledgement of Service must be filed at Court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an acknowledgement of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands, the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgement of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
