**PETITION**

**THIS PETITION** of GISLEYVY VALLADARES DE LA CRUZ of 16 Montrose Newlands, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands is for a decree of dissolution of marriage:

1. That on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2014 Petitioner was lawfully married to the Respondent at Dart Park George Town Grand Cayman. At the time of the said marriage, the marital status of the parties was as follows:

The Petitioner was a Spinster  
The Respondent was a Bachelor

2. That following the celebration of the said marriage, the Parties lived and cohabited at Anthony Drive Windsor Park, George Town Grand Cayman.
3. There are no children of the marriage.
4. That this Honorable Court has jurisdiction in this cause herein by reason of the fact that the Petitioner has been domiciled in the Cayman Islands within one year of the presentation of this Petition.
5. That the marriage has irretrievably broken down without any chance of a reconciliation between Parties, by reason of the fact that since the celebration of the marriage the Respondent has behaved in such a way that the Petitioner cannot reasonably be expected to live with him.

## PARTICULARS OF UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOUR

- a) The Respondent has shown disregard for the marriage and for the Petitioner.
  - b) The Respondent does not care for the Petitioner and he does not provide for her financially. He does not contribute to household expenses.
  - c) The Respondent is not supportive of the Petitioner emotionally and he gives her the silent treatment regularly.
  - d) There is no love in the marriage with a general loss of respect by the Respondent to the Petitioner.
  - e) The Respondent left the family home around 2017 to reside elsewhere.
  - f) The parties do not have any communications.
  - g) The parties are de facto separated as not residing together and having no contact.
  - h) The Petitioner is no longer willing to tolerate the behavior of the Respondent and cannot reasonably be expected to continue the marriage.
  - i) The parties have not cohabited since before 2017.
6. The Applicant believes that the marriage has broken down irretrievably and there is no prospect of any reconciliation between the parties.
  7. The Petitioner purchased a house in July 2018 and she is the sole name on the title and she alone pays the mortgage.
  8. The Respondent signed a waiver relinquishing his claim to any interest in the property.
  9. There are no assets of the marriage.
  10. The Petitioner believes that there is no impediment to this Court granting a decree of dissolution of said marriage and that there are no legal proceedings either inside or outside of the Cayman Islands in respect of the said marriage.
  11. There is no prospect of reconciliation whatsoever.

**THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:**

1. That the said marriage be dissolved;
2. That this Honorable Court grants any further or other relief as it deems just and fit.
