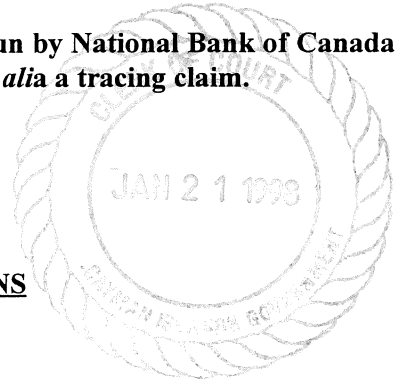
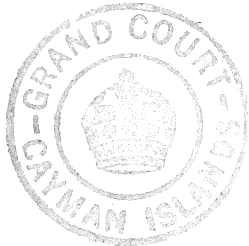


**In the matter of CONFIDENTIAL RELATIONSHIPS (PRESERVATION) LAW (1995 REVISION)**

**EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 21 day of JANUARY 1998 at 3:30 o'clock in the fore noon on the hearing of an application by Barclays Bank of P.O. Box 68, Grand Cayman:

1. for an Order that time for service of this Summons on the Attorney General be abridged, and
2. for directions pursuant to Section 4 of the above-mentioned law.

The Applicant is required by the terms of a Mareva Order obtained against each of the First to Fifth Defendants to disclose to the Plaintiffs, by means of swearing an affidavit and exhibiting to it the required documents, confidential information belonging to the Second to Fifth Defendants, to whom the Applicant owes a duty of confidentiality.
