IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Temporary case management stay

1. Pursuant to the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court the Set Aside Application is temporarily stayed pending formal handing down of the reserved judgment of the Cayman Islands Court of Appeal in CICA 15 of 2019 (on appeal from FSD 2 of 2019 (IKJ)) (***Reserved Judgment***).
2. Pursuant to clause B1.4(c) of the FSD Guide, the timetable for the parties to file and serve evidence in respect of the Set Aside Application shall be as follows:
 - (a) The Plaintiff is to file and serve evidence in response to the Set Aside Application 21 days after the date on which the Reserved Judgment is formally handed down.
 - (b) The Defendants are to file and serve evidence in reply 14 days after the Plaintiff has filed and served its evidence pursuant to paragraph 2(a).
3. The Defendants shall pay the Plaintiff's costs of the Stay Application.
4. Liberty to apply.
