PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION



The Petition of PATRICK ANTONIO MYRIE shows that:

1. On 14 July 2018 at 1 Cayman House, George Town, Grand Cayman, the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows:
 - Petitioner was divorced; and
 - Respondent was never married.
2. Following the celebration of the said marriage the parties lived together at 137 Moonbeam Drive, Savannah, Bodden Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. There is one child of the marriage, born 27 January 2019, named Leah Desiree Myrie.
4. The Court has jurisdiction of this matter by reason of the fact that the Petitioner has been domiciled in the Cayman Islands for a period in excess of one year prior to the presentation of this Petition.
5. There are no previous divorce proceedings brought by the parties hereto in connection with the marriage in any Court and there is no material impediment to this Court granting a decree of divorce.
6. That the Petitioner and the Respondent have lived separate lives in the same household for a continuous period over the last year until 3 August 2020 immediately preceding the presentation of this petition.

PARTICULARS OF UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOR

- a) On 4 July 2019, an argument erupted between the Respondent and the Petitioner over the Respondent seeing a picture on the Petitioner's phone, which resulted in the Petitioner being physically assaulted by the Respondent in the form of choking.
- b) The Respondent has been over jealous and her attitude disrespectful towards the Petitioner therefor causing a lack of trust in the marriage.
- c) When the Petitioner tries to make the Respondent leave the house, the Respondent acts by throwing water and kicking the Petitioner.


- d) The Respondent has violently jerked their minor daughter out of the Petitioners arms, which results in the infant crying.
- e) While trying to drop off their daughter to the Respondent, the Petitioner and his daughter encountered a naked man upon entering the room.
- f) The Petitioner is of the view that the marriage has broken down irretrievably due to the Respondent's attitude, behavior, and conduct and there is no prospect of reconciliation, and the Petitioner files under the grounds of unreasonable behavior under section 10 (1) (b) of the Matrimonial Causes Law 2005 Revision

THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:

- (i) That a Decree of Dissolution be granted with immediate effect.
- (ii) That each of the Petitioner and Respondent agrees that there are no ancillary matters to be determined in order to grant the Decree of Dissolution.
- (iii) That the Respondent do pay her costs and legal fees.

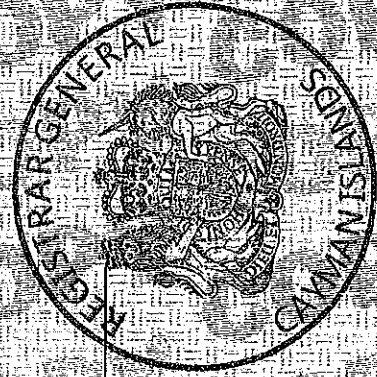

IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY.

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and her attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgment of Service must be filed at Court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that she intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open Court unless an acknowledgment of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
