**PETITION**

The Petition of **LILEITH ALTHEA FEARON-FARQUHARSON** shows that:

1. On the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2006 in the city of West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows:
  - Petitioner was a Divorcee
  - Respondent was a Divorcee
2. That following the celebration of the said marriage the parties lived together at 51 Bronze Road, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. That the Court has jurisdiction of this matter by reason of the fact that the Petitioner has been domiciled on the island for a period in excess of one year prior to the presentation of this Petition.
4. There are no previous divorce proceedings brought by the parties hereto in connection with the marriage in any Court and there is no material impediment to this Court granting a decree of dissolution of marriage.
5. That there is no children of the marriage.
6. That the marriage between the parties has broken down irretrievably without any chance of a reconciliation. We separated on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and have not lived together since that time. The parties to the marriage have lived apart for a continuous period of at least two years immediately preceding the presentation of the petition and the respondent consents to the decree being pronounced.

**THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:**

- (i) That the marriage be dissolved.
- (ii) That the Petitioner pays the costs of these proceedings.
- (iii) That there be such further and other relief as this Honourable Court deems just and equitable.

IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY.

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO Box 446 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgment of Service must be filed at Court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open Court unless an acknowledgment of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.


