

LET THE DEFENDANTS, attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 26th day of February, 1998 at 2:15 o'clock a.m. (p.m.) on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following orders:

1. That this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the sale by Private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Registry with absolute title and being particularly known as Parcel 91 of Block 13E in the George Town Central Registration Section of Grand Cayman ("the Property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the Property subject to a minimum sale price of CI\$450,000.00.
2. That the Defendants and any other person occupying the Property do, within 28 days of this Order, vacate the Property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the property.
3. That the Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this application and the costs of completion of the sale out of the proceeds of sale of the Property.
4. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within fourteen days after service of this summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
