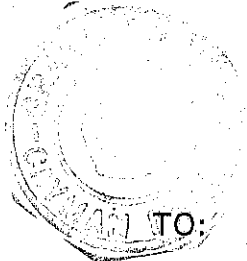
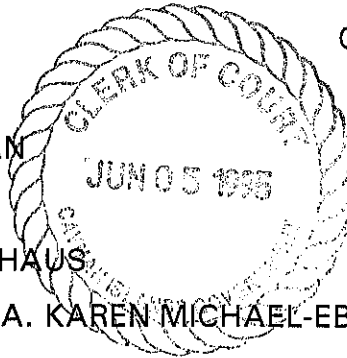

WRIT OF SUMMONS

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiffs may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiffs' claims are against the Defendants for the following Orders:

- (1) THAT the purported transfer of the following described properties:

Registration Section No. 24E 308

Registration Section No. 24E 309

Registration Section No. 95C 47H8

("the land") from the Second Defendant to the First Defendant allegedly dated July 15, 1991 and registered on September 16, 1992 in consideration of natural love and affection be set aside as being a disposition of property made with an intent to defraud and at an undervalue.

- (2) That the Land Register with respect to the land be rectified by canceling the last entries made in the proprietorship sections so that such sections show the proprietor of the land as being the Second Defendant.

- (3) interest;

- (4) costs;

- (5) further and other relief.
