

SUMMONS

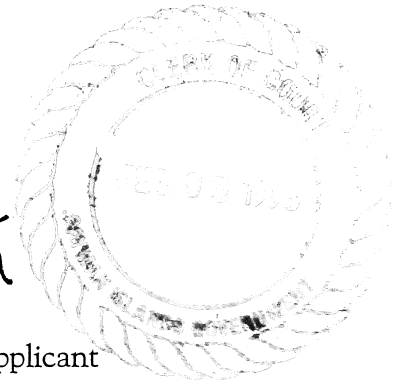
