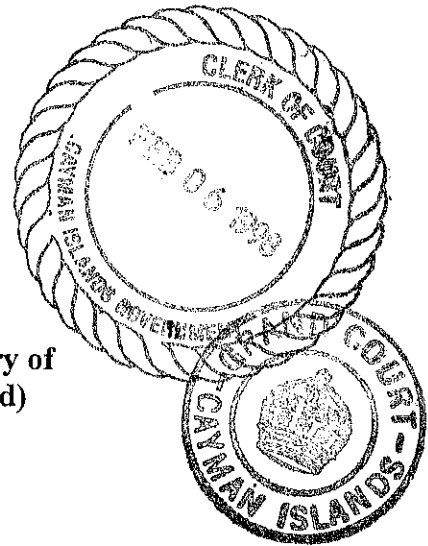

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

TO: ASLEY EBANKS AND LLOYD EBANKS
(Administrators of the Estate of Amon Ebanks, deceased)
West Bay, Grand Cayman.

AND TO: NORA DIANA HYDES
(Administratrix of the Estate of Beecher Amon Ebanks, deceased)
West Bay, Grand Cayman.

LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Henry Lee Ebanks, Dalson William Ebanks, Garland Ebanks, Crosby Ebanks, Frank Ebanks, Joseph Harmon Ebanks and Gleason Ebanks, of West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, B.W.I., the Plaintiffs' claim against the Defendants as follows:

1. A declaration that on the basis of illegitimacy, the 2nd Defendant and the issue of Beecher Ebanks, deceased, are excluded from the class of persons entitled to claim or benefit from the Estate of Amon Ebanks ("the Estate"), deceased or to any of the proceeds therefrom.
2. An order setting aside the Order of the Court made on the 10th September, 1997 declaring that the Estate of Beecher Ebanks, deceased, is entitled to one half share of West Bay North East, Block 9A, Parcel 240 ("the land").
3. An order for the removal of the Caution placed on the land by Nora Diana Hydes as Administratrix of the Estate of Beecher Ebanks, deceased.
4. A declaration that the persons entitled to claim or benefit from the said estate *per stirpes* are as follows:
 - the lawful issue of Henry Luke Ebanks,
 - the lawful issue of Julian Ebanks,


the lawful issue of Elvin Ebanks
the lawful issue of Elmy Ebanks,
the lawful issue Arvis Ebanks,
the lawful issue of Byron Ashley Ebanks,
and the lawful issue of Carrie Ebanks.

5. A declaration that the issue of Beecher Ebanks, or any illegitimate issue of any of the children of Amon Ebanks are not entitled to claim or benefit from the Estate.
6. An order restraining the Defendants or either of them from disposing of the land without leave of the Court.
7. An order that the Registrar of Lands do register an inhibition preventing the registration of any dealing with the land until further order.
8. An order for the sale of the land registered as West Bay North East, Block 9A, Parcel 240, subject to the directions of the Court free from incumbrances.
9. An order restraining the Administrators from distributing the proceeds of the said sale pending the determination of this action.
10. An order that the proceeds of the said sale be paid into Court pending the determination of this action.
11. Further or other relief.

12. Costs.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgement may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
