ORDER

UPON the application by *ex parte* Summons of China Bozza Development Holdings Limited (the "Company")

UPON HEARING COUNSEL for the Company and the Joint Provisional Liquidators

AND UPON READING the Second Affirmation of Lai Wing Lun sworn on 18 December 2020

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court shall issue a Letter of Request in the form annexed hereto ("Letter"), directed to the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the "Hong Kong Court") seeking its assistance in aid of the Court in this proceeding by ordering, *inter alia*, and if the Hong Kong Court shall consider it appropriate:
 - a. that the Order of 3 December 2020 (the "Order") appointing the Joint Provisional Liquidators ("JPLs") and today's Order be recognized such that the Order be treated in all respects in the same manner as if the Order had been made and the JPLs had been appointed by the Hong Kong Court, to the fullest extent permitted by Hong Kong law; and

- b. in accordance with such recognition, no action or proceedings shall be proceeded with or commenced against the Company within the jurisdiction of the Hong Kong Court except by leave of the Hong Kong Court and subject to such terms as the Hong Kong Court may impose.
2. The JPLs be at liberty to take such steps as they think fit to bring the Letter to the attention of the Hong Kong Court.
 3. That the Funding Agreement as defined in the Second Affirmation of Lai Wing Lun is hereby sanctioned and approved.
 4. The JPLs' costs of and occasioned by the *ex parte* Summons be paid on a first priority basis out of the assets of the Company.
