ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE RESPONDENT attend before the judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town Grand Cayman on Wednesday, 31st March 2021 at 9:30am on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff that:


1. The time for the hearing of the Originating Summons be abridged.
2. Within 14 days, the Respondent shall:
 - (a) serve on the Plaintiff's attorneys an affidavit sworn by a responsible officer, specifying the documents or records that are in its power, possession or control sought by the draft Order exhibited to the Affidavit of Wang, Chia Hsing dated 8 March 2021; and
 - (b) provide the Applicant's attorneys with copies of the documents sought in the draft Order exhibited to the Affidavit of Wang, Chia Hsing dated 8 March 2021.
3. The Respondent's reasonable costs, including its costs and expenses of complying with this Order, be paid by the Applicant.
4. By virtue of section 3(2) and/or section 3(1) of the Confidential Information Disclosure Act ("**CIDA**"):

- (a) the Respondent is not required to make an application pursuant to section 4 of the CIDA; and
- (b) the Respondent shall have a complete defence to any action for breach of confidence with respect to any information and documents disclosed to the Applicant pursuant to this Order.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of the Originating Summons on it counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

If the Respondent does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to it as the Court may think just and expedient.
