



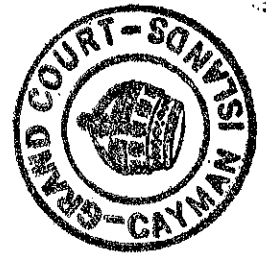

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 24th day of February, 1998.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim is for:-

1. A declaration that the defendant is not the legal owner of the land on Parcel 149 Block 14CJ George Town Central over which the defendant has a six foot right of way to Parcel 46.
2. An injunction to restrain the defendant whether by herself or by her servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from interfering with or molesting or preventing the plaintiff or his servants or agents from entering upon the land over which the right of way passes either to pave the said land or to work on the building or to walk around the said building.
3. An injunction to restrain the defendant whether by herself or by her servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from entering upon the plaintiff's land other than that over which the right of way passes.
4. Damages for trespass
5. Further or other relief.
