I, JOSEPH BERKLEY MCLEAN (d.o.b. 5-Sept-1942), of East End, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands hereby apply for a grant of letters of administration *de bonis non* of the estate of my late-Father JOSEPH BERKLEY MCLEAN (d.o.b. 12-Apr-1912), deceased of East End, Grand Cayman who died on or about 2 July 1956 intestate and to whose estate on the Letters of Administration of all of the estate which by law devolves on and vests in the personal representative of the said deceased was committed and granted to my brother JOHN BONWELL MCLEAN on 16 July 1982, by the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands in Cause No 169 of 1982, Probate and Administration No. 22/82, which grant now remains on record, who after commencing to administer the estate and effects of the late JOSEPH BURKLEY MCLEAN [*sic.*] died on the 24 August 2019 leaving part thereof unadministered.

And I annex hereto my Affidavit in support of my application and the Certificate of Death of the late JOHN BONWELL MCLEAN aka JOHN McLEAN (my brother).


