AND UPON reading the Third affidavit of Adam Bramble Clark sworn on 5 March 2021 and the exhibit thereto

AND UPON the *Petition* not having been advertised

AND UPON no notice of intention to appear and be heard on the *Petition* (whether in support or opposition) having been received from any creditor

AND UPON the *Company*, through its liquidators appointed by the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, confirming its support by letter dated 20 January 2021 to an order withdrawing the *Petition*


AND UPON the Court considering the *Petitioner's* application to be suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing
