
AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL LEAVE

1. I make this affidavit in support of my application for special leave, pursuant to s.4 of the Succession Act (2021 Revision), to apply for the grant of Letters of Administration in the estate of the late Festus Lawrence.
