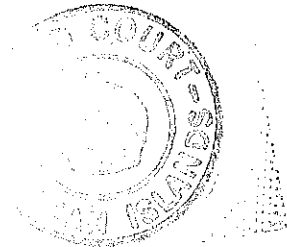

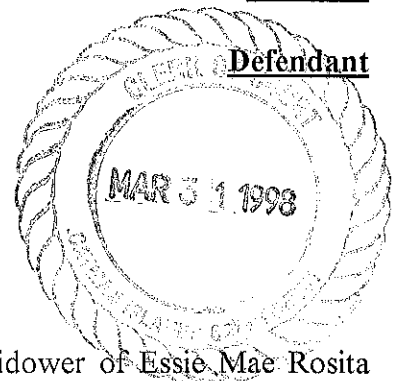

1. that special leave be granted to the Plaintiffs to apply for a grant of Letters of Administration of the estate of the Deceased
2. that notice of the application for a grant of Letters of Administration, by public posting in the Court House for three consecutive weeks, be waived

3. that Letters of Administration be granted to the Plaintiffs forthwith
4. that such further or other order be made as the Court thinks fit
5. that the Plaintiffs' costs be met out of the estate of the Deceased
