ORDER

UPON the Summons of the Joint Official Liquidators ("**JOLs**") of National Warranty Insurance Risk Retention Group (in Official Liquidation) (the "**Company**") dated 17 June 2021

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the JOLs

AND UPON reading the JOLs' final report and accounts dated 2 June 2021 (the "**Final Report**"), the Twenty First Affidavit of George Theodore Lanyon Bullmore ("**Bullmore 21**") and the First Affidavit of Rachel Catherine Baxendale, filed herein

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1 The requirement to publish a notice of hearing pursuant to CWR O.22, r.1(3) be dispensed with.
- 2 The Company be dissolved with effect from 11 September 2021 (the "**Date of Dissolution**").
- 3 The JOLs be discharged as official liquidators of the Company and released from the performance of any further duties as JOLs of the Company on the Date of Dissolution.
- 4 The JOLs' liquidation file shall be preserved by the JOLs for at least three years following the Date of Dissolution in accordance with CWR O.26, r.2(3).

- 5 The Company's books and records may be destroyed by the JOLs at any time on or after the Date of Dissolution.
- 6 The JOLs be permitted at any time from the date of this Order to transmit any unclaimed dividends remaining as at 15 January 2021 to the Financial Secretary.
- 7 The JOLs' remuneration be approved in the amount of \$6,688,052 (invoices raised and paid) plus \$236,388 (invoices raised and unpaid) as set out in Bullmore 21 and the Final Report.
- 8 The JOLs' costs of the application be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the official liquidation.
