**UPON** the application of Elizabeth Mackay and Benjamin Browne, the joint receivers over the segregated portfolios of Simplon Capital Ltd. SPC known as Quantum Global Opportunities Fund Segregated Portfolio and Refund Emerging Market Fund Segregated Portfolio (the "**Segregated Portfolios**") (the "**Receivers**") by way of Walkers' letter dated 19 August 2021 (the "**Application**")

**AND UPON** the Court being satisfied that the Application could be dealt with on the papers without the need for an oral hearing in accordance with section B1.1 of the Financial Services Division Guide, Second Edition

**IT IS DIRECTED** that:

1. the deadline of 20 August 2021 for the Receivers to submit a progress report to this Honourable Court be extended to the earlier of:
  - a. 20 October 2021;
  - b. the date upon which the Transaction Application (as defined in the Application) is determined; or

- c. such other time as the Receivers consider it to be appropriate to provide a further report (having regard to the progress of the receiverships)
