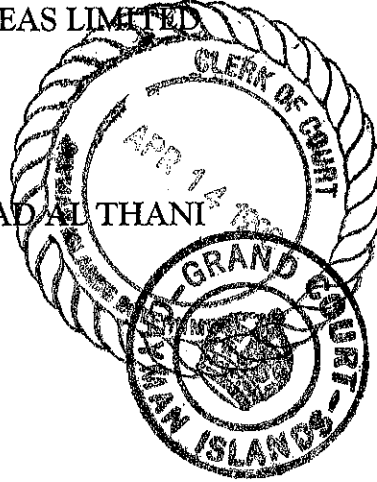

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

TO: The Defendant whose registered office is at UBS International Trustees Ltd., 3rd Floor, Zephyr House, Mary Street, P.O. Box 2325, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on it, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff of Villa Al Rayan, 7 Chemin des Collines, 06400 Cannes, France, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief:

1. an order pursuant to Section 45 of the Companies Law (1995 Revision) that the register of members of the Defendant company Strand Overseas Limited be rectified by the insertion of the Plaintiff's name in the said register as the holder of the three shares recorded as issued to bearer, being respectively shares numbers 4, 5 and 6, and that for such purpose the Defendant be directed to issue new share certificates to the Plaintiff in respect of the said shares;

2. an order that the Defendant be authorised and directed to do and execute all such documents, acts and things as may be necessary or desirable to implement and carry such order into full force and effect;
3. such further or other order, direction or relief as the Court shall think fit; and
4. that provision be made for the costs of the action.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
