ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION OF David Griffin and John Batchelor, the joint official liquidators (the "**JOLs**") of Ardon Maroon Asia Master Fund (in Official Liquidation) (the "**Company**") by way of Summons dated 30 September 2021 (the "**Application**")

AND UPON READING the Sixteenth Affidavit of David Griffin sworn on 17 November 2021 ("**Griffin 16**"), together with exhibit "**DG-16**" thereto

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Application is suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. the JOLs' fees and expenses incurred during the period from 1 June 2019 to the dissolution of the Company, as more particularly described in Griffin 16, be approved and paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation;
2. the Company be dissolved and the JOLs be discharged from office forthwith; and
3. the costs of and incidental to the Application be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation;

AND IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED THAT:

4. the JOLs' liquidation files shall be preserved for 3 years after the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files;

5. the Company's books and records shall be preserved by the JOLs for 3 years after the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such books and records;
6. the books and records in possession of the JOLs that relate to Ardon Maroon Asia Dragon Feeder Fund (in Official Liquidation) (the "**Dragon Records**") shall be preserved and stored by the JOLs for at least 3 years, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such Dragon Records;
7. in the event that any party to Cause No. FSD 19 of 2015 (RMJ) requests a copy of the Company's books and records and/or the Dragon Records (together, the "**Records**"), and such party demonstrates that it is entitled (or would have been entitled if the Company had not been dissolved) to obtain a copy of the Records, the JOLs' reasonable costs of and incidental to the collation and provision of the Records (which shall, for the avoidance of doubt, include the reasonable costs of the JOLs' review of such Records) shall be paid by the party requesting such Records; and
8. the JOLs shall file this Order with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days of the date of the Order.
