
PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. By an agreement in writing on October 27, 2021, the plaintiff and the defendant agreed that the defendant would construct the footing only for a 70ft concrete fence for the plaintiff.
2. Under the terms of the agreement, the plaintiff would provide the materials while the defendant provide the labour, The labour costs was CI\$1,100.00.
3. The on or about October 27, 2021, the plaintiff paid the defendant , which the defendant required, a deposit of CI\$650.00 to commence the work.
4. That on or about the 28th October, 2021, the defendant asked for and received a further CI\$450.00 which brought the total funds received by him to the sum of CI\$1,100.00 .
5. That since receiving the funds, the defendant has not commenced the work, giving the plaintiff excuses on top of excuses for not being able to commence the work.
6. The plaintiff has requested the return of his funds from the defendant or for him to commence and complete the construction of the said footing but he has, to date, failed to do either.
7. That accordingly, the defendant is in breach of his contract with the Plaintiff.
8. That by reason of the foregoing, the plaintiff has suffered loss and damage

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS FROM THE DEFENDANT:-

- .1. The sum of CI\$1,100.00.
2. Costs to be taxed, if not agreed.
3. Interest
