PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

On the 3rd day of August 2021, Mr. Alburn Brown obtained two contracts. This claim is for **contract number 2** personal salary guaranteed loans with the assistance of SEB Finance Consulting Cayman from Mr. Samuel Brown in the amount of CI\$2,000 with an interest rate of 20% due upon the expiration of the contract being 2nd of September 2021.

SEB Finance Consulting Cayman being the administrator appointed by the lender being Mr. Samuel Brown communicated via through email a reminder notice with conditions including waiving of some interest should payment be made within a time by October 25th,2021. No payment has been made to date.

Mr. Odell Suarez of SEB Finance spoke with Mr. Alburn Brown on the 2nd of November, Mr. Alburn Brown advised Odell Suarez that he did not receive the email **below**. Mr. Odell Suarez further told Mr. Alburn Brown that he did in fact contact him on the 12th of October 2021, advising Mr. Alburn of the email. Mr. Alburn Brown stated that he did not receive any email. Mr. Odell Suarez then forwarded the same email that was previously sent on the 12th of October, no return notification was received.

Mr. Alburn Brown then became very aggressive and threatened Mr. Odell Suarez stating that if Mr. Odell had been in front of him that he would see what he would do to him.

Noting that the contract is a 30-day contract, Over the course of 68 days Mr. Alburn Brown has yet to make a payment.
