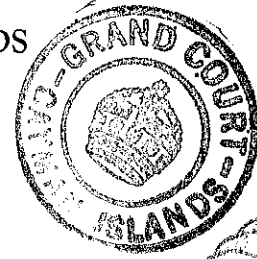

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: Wallace Robson, 48 Fairway Crescent, Amherstburg, Ontario N9V 3T6.

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 14th day of May 1998.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 6 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

### IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgement of Service are given with the accompanying form.

AND THE PLAINTIFFS claim:

1. The amount of the Judgment of the Ontario Court (General Division) entered in favour of the Plaintiffs against the Defendant herein dated 16 September 1996, namely Canadian \$2,306,263.07 (inclusive of interest to the date of the Judgment), together with their fixed costs of \$85,000, totalling \$2,391,263.07;
2. Interest on the above sum at the Ontario post-judgment rate of 5% per annum from 16 September 1996 until judgment in the present proceedings or earlier payment, and thereafter from the date of service of the judgment at the rate provided for in the schedule to the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1995 of 10 1/8% per annum. Interest accrued to the date hereof totals Canadian \$190,815.68 and, prior to judgment in the present proceedings, will continue to accrue at a daily rate of Canadian \$315 per day;
3. costs; and
4. further or other relief.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of Canadian \$2,391,263.07, together with interest to date of Canadian \$190,815.68 and fixed costs of CI \$6,817.88, using an exchange rate of Canadian \$0.5550 = CI \$1), further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiffs or their Attorney.
