**AND UPON** the Order of the Court in proceedings with cause number FSD 374 of 2021 dated 25 March 2022 sanctioning the Company's Scheme of Arrangement

**AND UPON** the Order of the Court dated 25 March 2022 discharging the Order dated 28 May 2021 appointing Margot MacInnis of Grant Thornton Specialist Services (Cayman) Limited and Mat Ng and Chow Tsz Nga Georgia of Grant Thornton Recovery & Reorganisation Limited (together, the **JPLs**) as joint provisional liquidators of the Company

**AND UPON** hearing counsel for the Petitioner and the Company

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Petitioner is granted leave to withdraw the Winding Up Petition and the Winding Up Petition shall be withdrawn on and from the time the Company delivers notice to the Petitioner that it has delivered a duly executed closing notice to, amongst others, the JPLs in accordance with Clause 7.1 of the Restructuring Implementation Deed entered into by, amongst others, the Company on 22 February 2022.
2. The Company shall pay the costs of the Petitioner.
