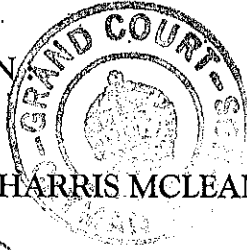

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: Richard Charles Harris III, of Lighthouse Pointe Drive, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands

AND TO: Ana Victoria Harris of 2, Cayman Coves, South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 26th day of May 1998.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgement of Service are given with the accompanying form.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. A declaration as to what moneys and assets in the hands of the Defendants are the assets of the Plaintiff or its clients;
2. All accounts and inquiries as to what has become of such moneys or assets;
3. An account of all secret profits made by the Defendants;
4. A declaration that all such moneys and assets are and have since their receipt by or on behalf of the Defendants or either of them been held on constructive trust in favour of the Plaintiff;
5. Delivery up of all such assets;
6. Damages for conspiracy to defraud, fraudulent and other misrepresentation, breach of contract, breach of trust, conversion, and/or trespass to goods and, as against the First Defendant only, breach of fiduciary duty;
7. Alternatively to damages for conversion, and/or trespass to goods, an order for specific restitution or redelivery of assets in respect of their detinue by the Defendants;
8. Interest in equity or pursuant to statute upon such sums as the Defendants may be ordered to pay, at such rate and for such period as the court deems just;
