2. In connection therewith the Defendant undertook to prepare and submit an application for Permission to Continue Working on behalf of the Plaintiff, in respect of which she charged a professional fee.
3. The Plaintiff provided the Defendant with all materials requested by the Plaintiff for the purposes of making the said application.
4. The Defendant advised the Plaintiff that such application had been filed on February 20th, 2022.
5. The Defendant failed to properly file the application for Permission to Continue Working.
6. On March 30th, 2022, the Plaintiff was advised by WORC that, as a result of the Defendant not having correctly filed the Plaintiff's application for Permission to Continue Working, they were not authorized to continue working pending the determination of their application for Permanent Residence. As a result of which the Plaintiff has been unable to work since such March 31st, 2022, and has suffered loss of income as a result.
7. The Plaintiff claims from the Defendant the sum of CI\$8000.00 in respect of loss of earnings suffered as a result of his inability to due to the Plaintiff's failure to correctly and timely submit the Plaintiff's application for Permission to Continue Working.
8. The Plaintiff claims from the Defendant the sum of CI\$250.00 in respect of additional costs incurred in connection with the submission of the Plaintiff's application for Permission to Continue Working as a result of the failure on behalf of the Plaintiff to correctly and timely file such application.
