AND UPON reading the Sixth Affidavit of Andrew Morrison sworn on 7 April 2022 together with the exhibit thereto, the Seventh Affidavit of Andrew Morrison sworn on 19 May 2022 ("**Morrison 7**") together with the exhibit thereto (filed in Cause No FSD 23 of 2020 (MRHJ)) and the Plaintiff's skeleton argument dated 19 May 2022

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Plaintiff

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Leave be granted to the Plaintiff to rely on Morrison 7 in relation to the Application.
2. That the validity of the Plaintiff's Writ of Summons dated 18 February 2020 (as extended on five previous occasions by Order of the Grand Court dated 17 August 2020, 21 December 2020, 20 April 2021, 24 August 2021 and 13 January 2022) be extended for an

additional period of four calendar months from the date upon which it would otherwise expire.
