**Within** fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**


1. The Plaintiff lives in George Town.
2. The defendant is a local Company which Registered Office is at International Corporation Services Ltd. - Attorneys-at-Law - P.O.Box 472G, Midland Bank Building in George Town
3. On the 24th day of April, 1995, the Director of Labour, by reason of his powers under section 67 of the Labour Law, Law 30 of 1987, ordered that the defendant pay the plaintiff, by the 10th day of May, 1995 the following sums:-

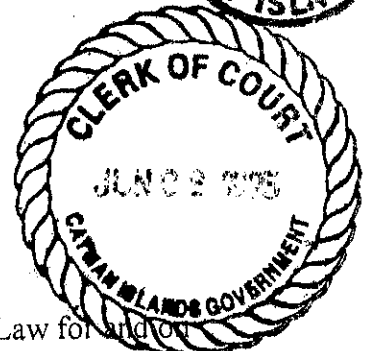
i.	Severance pay	= \$ 760.00; and
ii.	Compensation	= \$ 946.70
	<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>= \$1,706.70</b>
4. A copy of the Order was sent to Spanish Bay reef but the defendant has failed to pay.

WHEREFORE, by reason of **Section 68 (2) of the Labour Law**, the Claims:-

1. the amount due \$1,706.70
2. Interest at the rate of 83/8% per annum from the 10th May, 1995 until payment
4. Costs to be taxed.

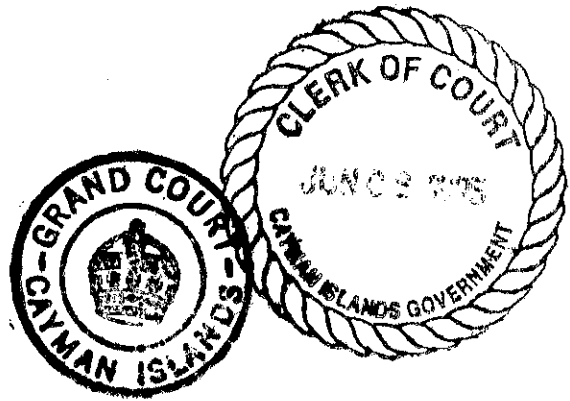
**Notes on address for service**
