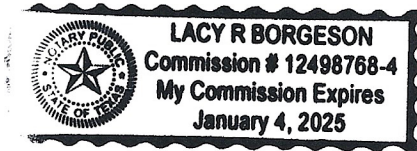

POUR-OVER LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF ROBERT E. ALLEN

I, Robert E. Allen of Sullivan County, Tennessee, declare this to be my Last Will and Testament and revoke all earlier wills and codicils.

ARTICLE I: My Family

At the time that I sign this Will my immediate family group consists of the following

My Son Steven Robert Allen, M.D.

My Daughter Sandra Kae Allen Faidley

My Daughter Shelley Rae Allen Greene

The provisions of this Will shall not be revoked if I have more children.

ARTICLE II: My Fiduciaries

A. Appointment Of Personal Representatives. I hereby appoint my son, Steven Robert Allen, M.D. to be my personal representative. If Steven Robert Allen, M.D. is unwilling or unable to serve, I name my daughters, Sandra Kae Allen Faidley and Shelley Rae Allen Greene to serve as my co-personal representatives. If either Sandra Kae Allen Faidley or Shelley Rae Allen Greene is unwilling or unable to serve, the other shall serve alone. If it becomes necessary for a Personal Representative of my estate to qualify in any jurisdiction in which my Personal Representative is unable or unwilling to qualify as Personal Representative, then my Personal Representative shall have the right to appoint an individual or corporate co-representative of my estate to serve in such jurisdiction.

B. Waiver Of Bond, Inventory, Accountings And Court Supervision. No bond or other security shall be required from any fiduciary serving hereunder. Any fiduciary may act without qualifying before any court or filing with any court any inventory, accounting, settlement or other report relating to the administration of my estate or any trust created hereunder unless otherwise required by law to do so.

C. Compensation Of Fiduciaries. Any individual fiduciary may receive reasonable compensation for such fiduciary's services. A corporate fiduciary may receive compensation for its services in accordance with its published schedule of fees in effect at the time the services are rendered. I am aware that the persons named herein may be reluctant to request compensation for services as a fiduciary hereunder; however, although no fiduciary is required to request compensation, I encourage any person named herein who serves as a fiduciary hereunder to request compensation for the reasonable value of his or her services. A total fee to my Personal Representatives which does not exceed two and one half percent (2.5 %) of my

gross estate as the same would be determined for Tennessee inheritance tax purposes, or a minimum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), shall in all cases be deemed reasonable.

D. Accountings And Other Proceedings. I direct that in any proceeding relating to my estate or a trust hereunder, service upon any person under a legal disability need not be made when another person not under a disability is a party to the proceeding and has the same interest as the person under the disability. The person under the disability shall nevertheless be bound by the results of the proceeding. The same rule shall apply to non-judicial settlements, releases, exonerations and indemnities.

**ARTICLE III: Payment Of Debts, Expenses And Death Taxes**

A. Payment Of Debts And Expenses. All my legally enforceable debts, expenses of my last illness, unpaid charitable pledges (whether or not they are enforceable obligations of my estate), funeral expenses and the administration expenses of my estate shall be paid out of my residuary estate. However, I direct that if any property in my estate is bound by any mortgage, lien or other encumbrance, then the recipient of such property shall take it subject to such mortgage, lien or other encumbrance.

B. Payment Of Death Taxes. All death taxes (other than death taxes which are paid from property passing outside of this Will pursuant to the terms of the governing instrument) shall be paid out of my residuary estate as an administration expense and shall not be charged against or recovered from any recipient of the property taxed, except that my Personal Representatives shall recover as provided by law any death tax attributable to property (i) over which I have a power of appointment, (ii) in which I have a qualifying income interest for life or (iii) in which I have a retained interest for life to the extent that any death tax recoverable by law is not otherwise paid out of such property.

C. Payment Of Debts, Expenses And Death Taxes Out Of Trust If Residuary Estate Is Insufficient. If my residuary estate is insufficient, either in whole or in part, to pay all of my debts, health care expenses, funeral expenses, the administration expenses of my estate and the death taxes payable out of my residuary estate, my Personal Representatives shall certify to the Trustees acting under the trust instrument referred to below the amount of the insufficiency which amount shall be paid out of the property of the trust as provided in that instrument.

D. Property Exempt from Death Taxes. So long as other property is available, none of my debts, health care expenses, funeral expenses, the administration expenses of my estate and the death taxes payable out of my residuary estate shall be paid from any property which would otherwise be exempt from death taxes imposed by reason of my death.

**ARTICLE IV: Disposition of Estate**

A. Distribution Of Personal Effects. All my personal effects have previously been transferred to The Robert E. Allen Revocable Living Trust dated

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**June 6th, 2013.** All of my personal effects not held by the Trustees shall be distributed to the Trustees acting under **The Robert E. Allen Revocable Living Trust**. The term "personal effects" includes clothing, jewelry, motor vehicles, household furniture and furnishings, household appliances, silverware, glassware, china, collectibles, pets and all other tangible personal property not otherwise disposed of herein, which I own at my death, excluding, however, tangible personal property held primarily for investment or used or held for sale in a business. Furthermore, such term includes private club memberships, airline frequent flyer miles, hotel loyalty program benefits, credit card program benefits and benefits of similar travel programs. That term also includes all of my interest in casualty insurance policies insuring any of these personal effects against loss or liability, including prepaid premiums and claims thereon. My Personal Representatives shall make a binding and conclusive determination as to whether the term "personal effects" includes any particular asset.

B. **Distribution Of Residuary Estate.** My residuary estate, being all of my real and personal property, wherever located, not otherwise effectively disposed of, but excluding any property over which I may have a power of appointment, shall be disposed of as follows:

1. My residuary estate shall be distributed to the Trustees acting under **The Robert E. Allen Revocable Living Trust**, previously executed by me as Grantor and as Trustee on even date herewith, to be added to and disposed of as part of the trusts created under the provisions of that trust instrument, including any amendments to it in effect at the time of my death.

If for any reason the disposition directed in subparagraph I above shall be ineffective, then my residuary estate shall be distributed to the Trustees named in accordance with **The Robert E. Allen Revocable Living Trust** referred to above to be added to and disposed of under the provisions of that trust instrument, including the provisions of any amendments to said Trust in effect at the time of my death, the provisions of which Trust and amendments are incorporated herein by reference with the same effect as though set forth verbatim herein.

**ARTICLE V: Administrative Powers Of Fiduciaries**

In addition to the powers conferred by law or elsewhere in this Will, I grant to my Personal Representatives with respect to the property in my estate (including all my real property which shall be treated as personality in the administration of my estate), and to the Trustees with respect to the property in any trust established under this Will, the discretionary powers set forth below to be exercised without court order for any purpose that my Personal Representatives or Trustees may deem advisable:

A. **Powers Incorporated By Reference.** All the powers set forth in Tennessee Code Annotated §35-50-110 as they exist at the time that I sign this Will, and such powers are incorporated by reference with the same effect as though set forth verbatim in it.

B. **Retention Of Assets To Cover Liabilities.** Where required to make a distribution or transfer of all or part of the assets of my estate, my fiduciaries may retain therefrom assets sufficient in their judgment to cover any liability which may then or late be

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imposed upon them including, but not limited to, liabilities for state or federal taxes until such liabilities shall have been finally determined.

C. Power of Fiduciaries To Enter Into Agreements. My fiduciaries may enter into agreements with appropriate governmental authorities and may make such elections concerning my estate or any assets in my estate and may exercise any elections available on state or federal tax returns, in such manner as my fiduciaries may deem advisable.

D. Certain Tax Elections. My Personal Representatives may determine whether and to what extent to elect to qualify any eligible property for the Federal or state marital deduction, even though a Personal Representative may have an interest affected by this election.

**ARTICLE VI: Definitions for purpose of this Will**

A. "Death Taxes." The term "death taxes" means inheritance, estate, generation skipping, transfer and succession taxes, and any interest and penalties on these taxes, imposed by reason of my death by any jurisdiction with respect to property passing under or outside of the provisions of this Will or any codicil to it which is includible in my estate for the purpose of determining such tax.

B: "Personal Representative," "Trustee" and "Fiduciary." The term "Personal Representative" or "Personal Representatives" includes any personal representatives of my estate acting under this Will such and includes any executor, executrix, administrator, administratrix, and any administrator with the Will annexed. The term "Trustee" or "Trustees" includes any Trustee or Trustees acting under a trust to which property passes pursuant to this Will, and the term "fiduciary" or "fiduciaries" includes a Personal Representative, a Trustee and a Guardian.

**ARTICLE VII: Identification Of Attorney**

Should any questions arise as to the construction or application of this instrument, or as to any of its provisions, or if legal counsel is needed by my Personal Representatives, Trustees or my beneficiaries in administering this instrument, I suggest that my fiduciaries or my beneficiaries consult with Eric S. Ratliff, Esq. of the Ratliff Law Firm.
