EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 29th day of June, 1998, at 9-30 o'clock in the fore/afternoon on the hearing of an application by Gary Oakley (the "Applicant") on his own behalf and on behalf of Britannia Corporate Management Ltd., and Britannia Directors Ltd. all of P.O. Box 1968, Whitehall Estates, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, for directions pursuant to Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision).


The Applicant is required by summons dated 18th February, 1998, to attend before an Investigator appointed by the BCSC under Section 144 of the Securities Act R.S.B.C., 1996, c. 418, at a time and date to be fixed, to give evidence under oath and to produce all records and things in his possession or power in connection with, inter alia, the arrangement and operation of Excel Funding Inc. ("Excel Funding"), the Excel Funding Trust, Diomondmark Investments Limited ("Diomondmark Investments"), the Diomondmark Trust and the role played by Mr. Gary Stanhiser and certain other named persons or companies in connection with a scheme of investment in British Columbia, Canada, operated by or through Excel Funding and Diomondmark Investment.

By the said summons, the Applicant is required to give in evidence, confidential information belonging to Excel Funding, Diomondmark Investments, and to the Aurinko Rahat Trust as the

successor trust to the Excel Funding Trust and the Diomond Trust and/or Mr. Gary Stanhiser as the beneficial owner of those companies and/or as the ultimate beneficiary of the said Trust. The Applicant therefore seeks the following orders and directions:

1. Such directions as this Honourable Court deems fit and proper as to whether, and if so, subject to what conditions, the Applicant may be permitted to disclose the confidential information particularised in the first affidavit of the Applicant filed herein, by way of evidence before the BCSC either pursuant to the said summons dated 18th February, 1998, or at the hearing of the proceeding or otherwise.
2. That this Honourable Court do give such further or other directions as it deems just.
