**GENERAL INDORSEMENT**

The Plaintiff was a passenger seated in the front passenger seat of a silver 2002 Honda motorcar licensed 177139 owned by the 2<sup>nd</sup> defendant, and being driven westerly on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July 2019 along the Anton Bodden Drive by the 1<sup>st</sup> defendant. The 1<sup>st</sup> defendant drove at a high rate of speed, lost control of the vehicle which veered off the road colliding into a heap of crush and a large rock, continued through bushes and overturned off Ena Close. The first defendant negligently failed to control the vehicle, failed to drive within the prescribed speed limit and failed to drive in a safe manner. The 1<sup>st</sup> defendant was driving the motorcar with the permission and consent of the 2<sup>nd</sup> defendant. As a result of the accident, the plaintiff suffered an open fractured jaw, pain to her chest, back, left arm and left leg. The full cost and extent of the plaintiff's injuries are still ongoing and will exceed 20,000.00kyd.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- 1 Damages for pain, suffering and loss of amenities, continuing and to be assessed
- 2 Costs of legal expense and medical treatment continuing and to be assessed; and
- 3 Further or other relief as the Court deems appropriate.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
OF WRIT OF SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person.

After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

2. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve a defence on the Attorney for the Plaintiffs (or on the Plaintiffs if acting in person).

If a Statement of Claim is indorsed on the Writ (i.e. the words "Statement of Claim" appear on the top of page 2), the Defence must be served within 14 days after the time for acknowledging service of the Writ, unless in the meantime a summons for judgment is served on the Defendant.

If the Statement of Claim is not indorsed on the Writ, the Defence need not be served until 14 days after a Statement of Claim has been served on the Defendant.

If the Defendant fails to serve his defence within the appropriate time, the Plaintiffs may enter judgment against him without further notice.

3. A Stay of Execution against the Defendant's goods may be applied for where the Defendant is unable to pay the money for which any judgment is entered. If a Defendant to an action for a debt or liquidated demand (i.e. a fixed sum) who does not intend to contest the proceedings states, in answer to Question 3 in the Acknowledgment of Service, that he intends to apply for a stay, execution will be stayed for 14 days after his Acknowledgment, but he must, within that time, issue a Summons for a stay of execution, supported by an affidavit of his means. The affidavit should state any offer which the Defendant desires to make for payment of the money by instalments or otherwise.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Writ of Summons)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for guardian ad litem.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
